- For those who are eager to continue the fun – a wine tasting at the unique Schuchmann winery.
- We will finish the day with dinner at the hotel.

## Day 4: Wine tasting and lake Ilia.

- After breakfast, we will embark on a journey through time from the 4th to the 6th century.
- We will visit:
  - Gremi monastery complex.
  - Ancient Nekresi Monastery.
- Then we will go to Kvareli for wine tasting and lunch.
- And of course, the day will not do without walks around lake Ilia.
- We will have dinner at our place.

## Day 5: Bread and Wine!

- After breakfast we will go to the Chavchavadze Estate and Museum in Tsinandali Gardens.
- Next, we will visit:
  - Shumi winery, famous for its vineyard with selection of rare grape varieties. It is the only place in the whole region where you can see a collection of endemic varieties. A real treat for connoisseurs.
  - Ethnographic Museum.
- The highlight of the programme will be wine tasting with a masterclass on bread baking in a traditional tonne oven.
- After lunch we return to the hotel.
- We will finish the day with a delicious dinner.

## Day 6: Let's meet the people of the country's smallest city!

- After breakfast we will head to the fortress city of Signagi. On the programme:
  - Lunch on the hillside overlooking the Old Town.
  - Bodbe Monastery.
  - Niko Pirosmani Museum.
- On your return, dinner at the hotel, exquisite wine and long conversations under the star-studded night sky.
